- **2. Program Resource Development and Workshop Facilitator announcement:** Heloise Dixon-Warren was selected for the position.   - ➤ Lori: the steering committee should guide the project to ensure timelines, budget, and evaluation are progressing.
  - ➤ Cathy: the steering committee should act as a sounding board if other committee members have suggestions or comments.
  - ➤ Robin: Budgets, oversite and press releases. Perhaps the newspaper will accommodate a newspaper column from the committee every 2-4 weeks as the project progresses.
  - Colleen: It is good to ensure the committee is meeting goals
