1. Welcome and introductions: Designated Chair: Cathy Juric

2. Empowering Family Health Stream 2 progress report:

- Update on program promotion at Farmers Market in June: Lori -Many contacts made and more people signed up for the workshop email list. The sandwich board was effective in drawing people to the booth.
- Seedy Saturday evaluation report did it get completed? Yes sent to Heloise
- Status of workshop scheduling and implementation: Issues with Bouchie Lake Community Association continue, so the recreation facilities at Baker Creek Community Hall will be used for workshops. This location is central to Bouchie Lake and Nazko. Contact person is Sheila Gibbons, who has been very supportive and helpful.
- Challenges presented by wild fires and ongoing state of emergency: The Kersley workshops will go ahead in September, but the 3rd foraging workshop did not go ahead. Heloise suggested we offer a Fermented Vegetable & Kombucha Workshop in 3 communities.
- Next steps-ideas and discussion: Create a new Empowering Family Health brochure, which incorporates values and advantages to the program i.e. connecting with community

3. Updates:

Country Club and Parkland Garden;
 Bouchie Lake Country Club – they built a portable community garden with really good turnout. They built planters and put in the garden, which grew well.

Participants watered every day. Need more people picking the produce; had a nice luncheon using the produce from the garden. Would like to build cold frames to extend the growing season.

Parkland Garden – Have 50 by 100 ft. gardening space and built boxes 4 ft. wide using 2 by 6 ft. boards. School is supportive of efforts and there has been good support of in-kind labour by community members and donations from the community. A compost was built and water tanks were purchased and filled throughout the season by the fire hall. They grew a nice selection, but more volunteer support was needed throughout the season, especially at planting time. Communicating with Moose Heights has been a challenge.

 Skills in the Kitchen; Very popular and Heloise will work towards offering another workshop – perhaps at Baker Creek. Sue expressed an interest in becoming an instructor for Skills in the Kitchen. It involves several days of training outside of the North Cariboo.

MOTION: Lori Fogarty moves the \$250 of funding allocated to the Fall Fair but not used due to cancellation, be used to assist in transportation to attend the Skills in the Kitchen training workshop for Sue Myles. Seconded by Tara Johima. **Carried**
